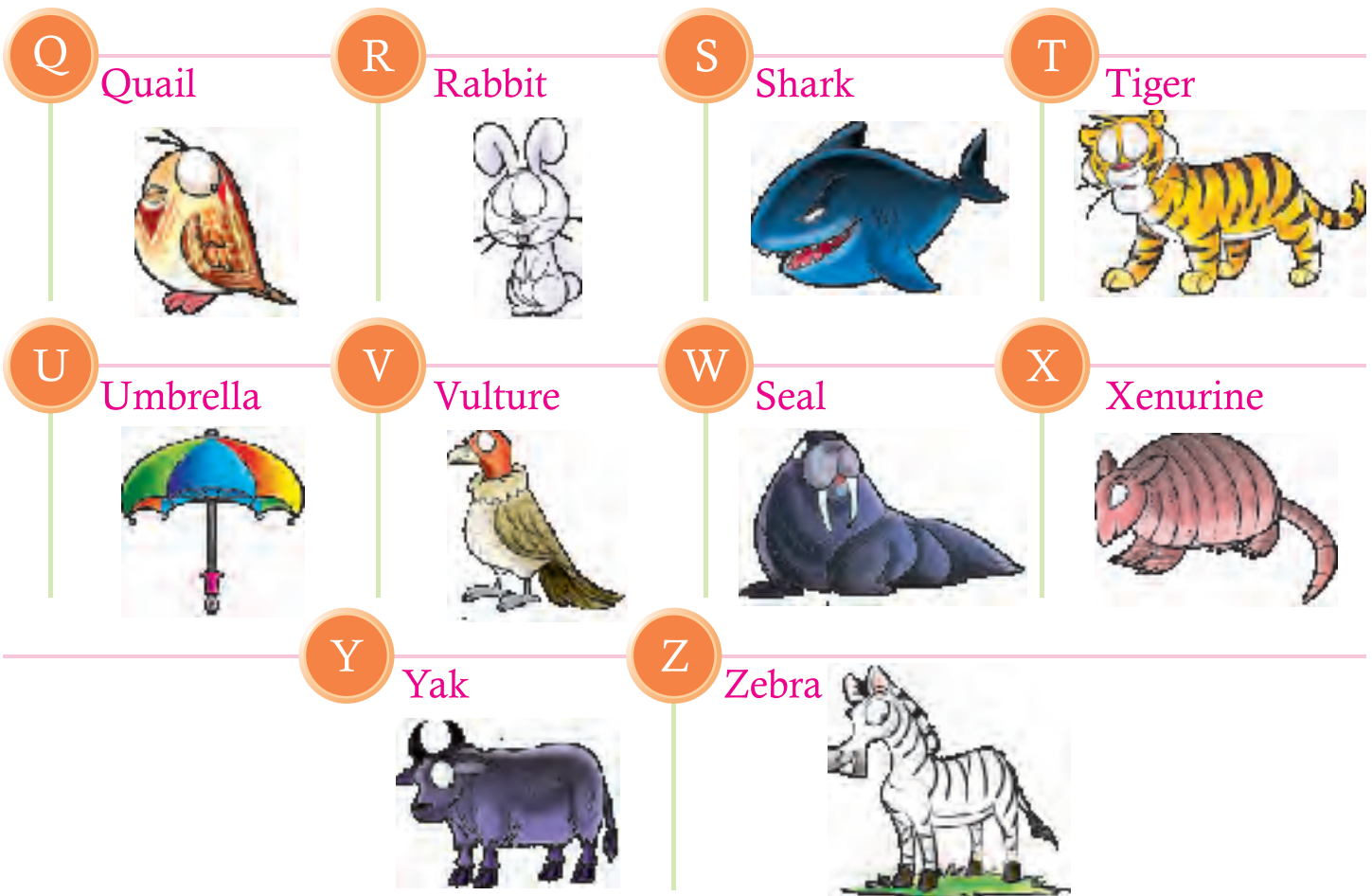

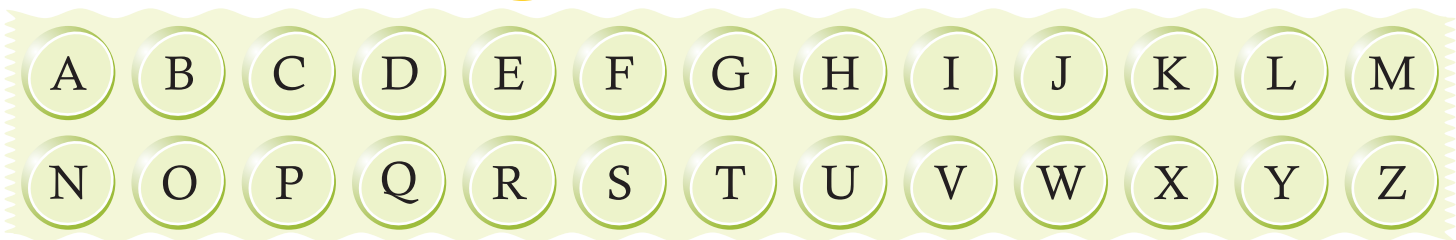




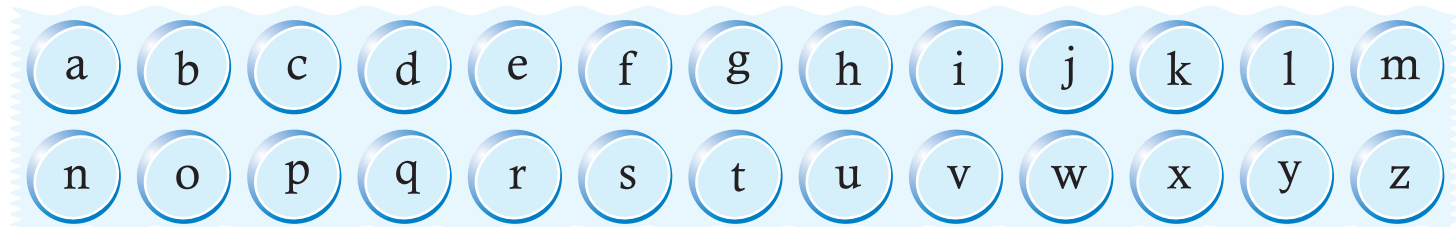
We can write these letters in two different ways. These are Capital Letter or Upper Case and Small Letter or Lower Case.

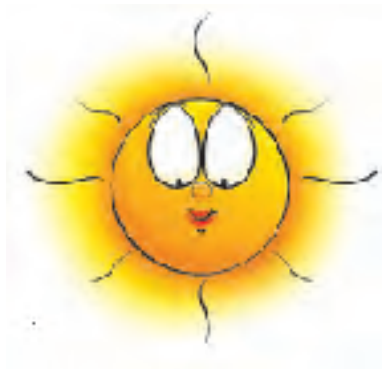
