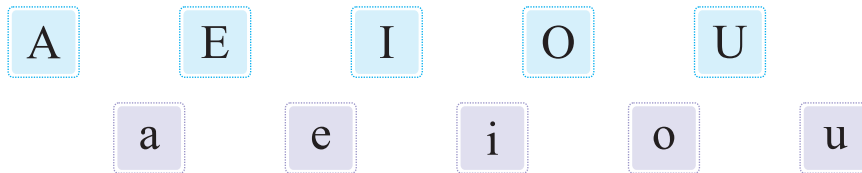
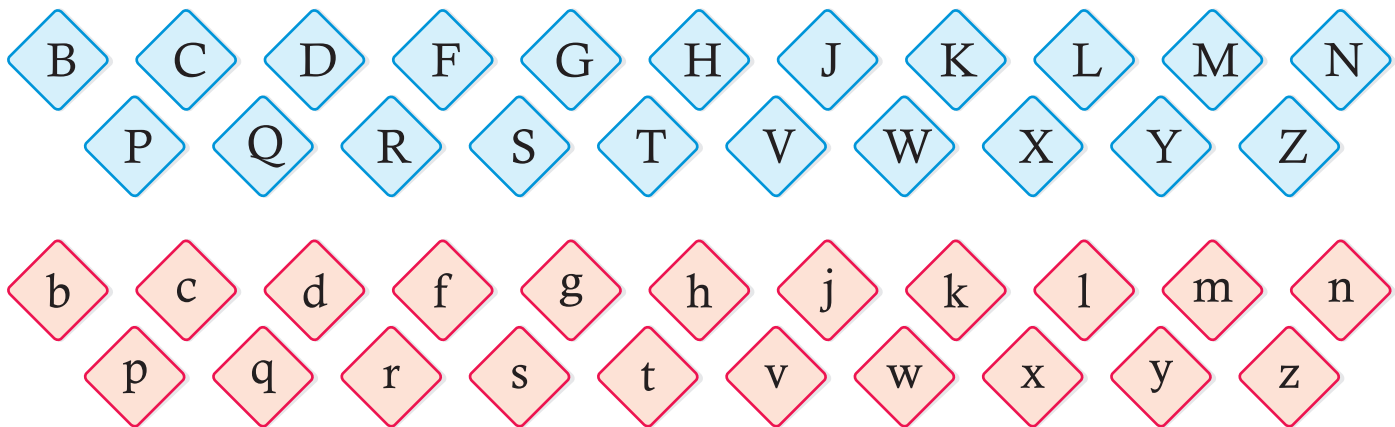


We divide the 26 letters of English Alphabet in two groups. Five of these letters are called Vowels. These five letters are:

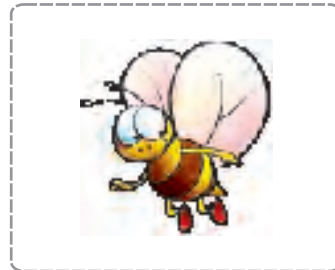

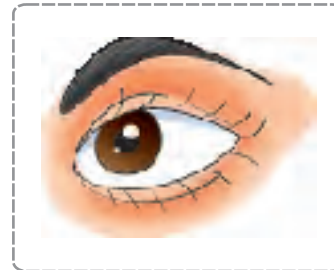

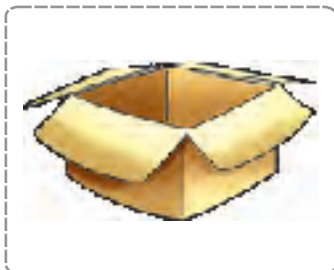
