


There are 26 letters in English Alphabet. All these letters are arranged in a certain order. This order is known as Alphabetical Order:

Look at the pictures and read the words below each:



Are the names in Alphabetical Order? No, they are not. Now, let us rearrange them as follows:

Ant Elephant Lion Peacock Rabbit

Now they are in proper order.

Remember: The words in a dictionary are always arranged in Alphabetical Order.

Now read the following words:

boy banana biscuit bucket beam

Here, all the above words start with the letter '-b'. How can we arrange these letters in Alphabetical Order?

Since all the words begin with the same letter '-b', we need to look at the second letter of each word and arrange them in Alphabetical Order. Let us follow this rule and rearrange the words as under:

banana beam biscuit boy bucket

Remember: If the second letter is also same, we look at the third letter and so on. We follow this rule for the words beginning with any letter.





