## Proper Noun (Special Names)

All naming words are nouns. Some naming words can have special names. They are called **Proper Nouns**.

Look at the pictures and read the sentences below each:



**Ravi** flies a kite.



**Anu** can dance well.



**Ted** is my pet dog.

The words in colour are special names. **Ravi** is the special name of a boy; **Anu** is the special name of a girl and **Ted** is the special name of a dog.

A Proper Noun is the special name of a person, place, animal or thing. All special names begin with a capital letter.
