

Look at the pictures and read the sentences below each:



There is a flower vase on the table.



There is no sugar in the milk.



Many ducks are swimming in the pond.



The train has not yet arrived at the station.

Is there any difference between these sentences? Yes, there is.

Sentence nos. 1 and 3 give positive sense. They are called Affirmative (Positive) Sentences. Sentence nos. 2 and 4 give negative sense. They are called Negative Sentences.

Thus, we see that an Affirmative (positive) Sentence makes a positive statement while a Negative Sentence makes a negative statement.

Remember: An Affirmative Sentence can be changed into Negative by adding 'no' or 'not' in it.

Let us read some more examples:

Affirmative	Negative	
1. There is a bag on the table.	There is no bag on the table.
