

Read the following conversation between the teacher and a new Student:

Teacher: What is your name?

Student: My name is Anek.

Teacher: How old are you?

Student: I am seven years old.

Teacher: What is your father?

Student: My father is a doctor.

Teacher: What is your mother?


Student: My mother is a housewife.

You can see that the teacher is asking some questions to the student who is giving answers. All these questions start with a question word.

Remember: 'Who', 'Which', 'Whom', 'Why', 'Where', 'What', 'When', 'Whose' and 'How' are called question words. Since they start with 'W' (except 'How') they are called 'W' words also.

The questions that start with a question word cannot be answered in 'yes' or 'no'.

You can see that the question words are always placed at the beginning of the questions and the linking verbs come thereafter.
