

As we have already learnt, a Noun is the name of a person, place, animal or thing. Nouns are mainly of five types. They are: Proper Noun, Common Noun, Collective Noun, Material Noun and Abstract Noun.



A Proper Noun is the special name of a particular person, place, animal or thing.



Ramlal is working in the garden.



The Taj Mahal is situated in Agra.



Bruno is my pet dog.

A Common Noun is the common name given to all persons, places, animals or things of the same class or kind.

A Collective Noun is the name given to a group or collection of persons, animals or things considered as one complete whole.

A Material Noun is the name of the material of which a thing can be made.

An Abstract Noun is the name of a quality, condition, state, thought or feeling etc. which can neither be seen nor touched; it can only be felt.
