

# The Noun: Number

## Read the following sentences carefully:

- The boy is writing with a pen.
- 3. He is talking to me.

- The cow is grazing in the field.
- 4. She is very happy.

In sentences 1 and 2, the nouns boy, pen and cow refer to one person, thing or animal.

In sentences 3 and 4, the pronouns he, me and she refer to one person.

These nouns and pronouns are said to be in Singular Number.

The word (noun or pronoun) which stands for one person, animal, thing or place is said to be in Singular Number.

#### Read the following:

- Boys are writing with pens.
- They are talking to us.

- 2. Cows are grazing in the field.
- 4. We are sorry for our mistake.

In sentences 1 and 2, the nouns boys, pens and cows refer to more than one person, thing or animal.

In sentences 3 and 4, the pronouns they, us, we and our refer to more than one person.

These nouns and pronouns are said to be in Plural Number.

### Thus, there are two numbers in English:

1. Singular

2. Plural


