# **Plants Around Us**

### **About the Lesson**

We see different kinds of plants around us. Some of these are small whereas some are very big.

Trees make our surroundings green and beautiful. They too have life.



#### **Trees**

Some plants are tall and very big. Their trunk is thick and very strong. These tall, large and strong plants are called trees.

Some trees are tall and straight. Their roots go deep into the earth, such as eucalyptus, fir, coconut, papaya, etc.



#### Remember

\* We get food and pure air from plants.



Strange But True

The Redwood tree located near the seashore in California is the tallest tree in the world.



Some trees look like an umbrella. Their upper part spreads like an umbrella, such as banyan, neem, gulmohar, mango, etc.

## **Shrubs**

Some plants are of medium size. They are neither too big nor too small.

From the lower part of their stem, many branches arise. These plants stand straight. Their branches usually bear thorns. These are known as shrubs, such as lemon, rose, henna, bougainvillea, etc.

#### Herbs

Some plants are very small in size. Their stem is very thin and soft. These plants stand straight in the soil. These are known as herbs, such as wheat, gram, tomato, mint, etc.









## **Creepers (Climbers)**

The stems of some plants are very weak. Such plants need support to grow and to spread on the earth. These plants cannot stand straight. These are known as creepers, such as melon, pea, money plant, grape, etc.









Some plants live for a very long time, such as mango, peepal, neem, etc.



Some plants live for a very short period, such as potato, peas, tomato, etc.
