Family



We all are members of a family. A family is made up of mother, father, brother and sister living together.

All the members of a family love each other. A family may be of following types :

1. Nuclear family 2. Joint family

Remember

A small family is a happy family.

1. Nuclear Family

Parents and their children live in a nuclear family. It may be small or big.

Small Family

A small family is a happy family. It has one or two children and their parents. All the needs of a small family are fulfilled easily. The needs of the family members such as clothes, food and housing are satisfied easily. Children are provided with good education.







Big Family

A big family is not a happy family. It has three or more children and their parents. The needs of a big family are also more. All the family members are not happy. Their needs for food, clothes and education are not satisfied. The children keep on quarrelling, and this worries the parents.

Teacher's Corner


- Encourage the students to tell about their family members. Do they live in a Nuclear Family or a Joint Family?

Advantages of Nuclear Family

Following are the advantages of a nuclear family:

It needs less space to live. All its needs can be satisfied easily. Children get good education. Parents take care of the family.



2. Joint Family

In a joint family, two or more than two nuclear families live together. It has grandparents, parents, uncle-aunt and their children living together. The grand father is the head of the family. There are problems in such a family as all its needs are not satisfied.



Disadvantages of a Joint Family

A joint family needs more space to live. It is nearly impossible to fulfill the needs of every member. All the children do not get equal care. It is difficult to satisfy the needs of food, clothes, medical care and other needs of the members.
