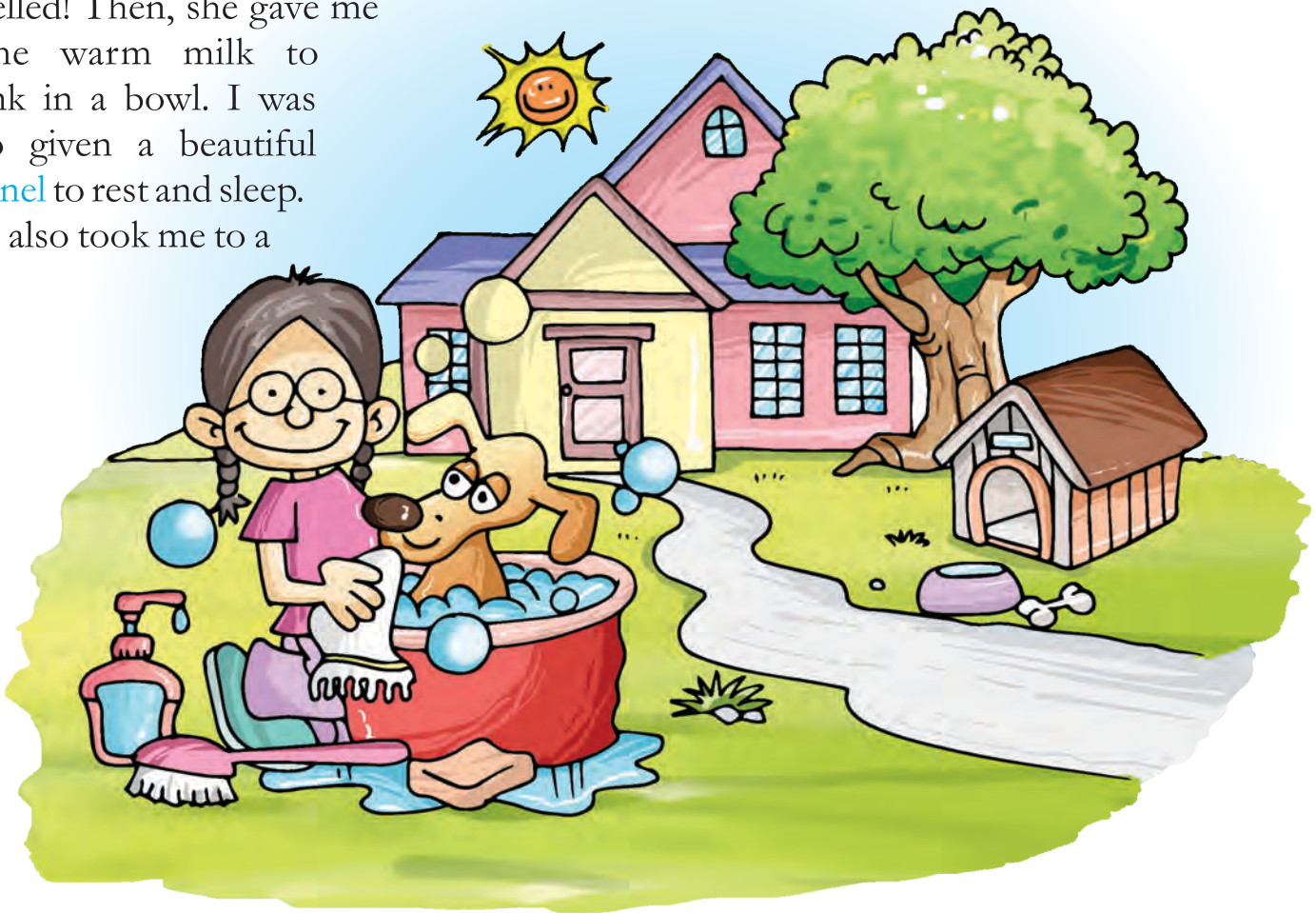
Neena and Fido
