6 THE MARINE LIFE

Marine animals are aquatic animals that rely on the ocean and other marine ecosystems for their existence.

Some extraordinary marine creatures are given below. Read the clues and name them.

1



This rare shark is often called a 'living fossil'. It has many primitive features.

2



This creature is banded with broad white and black bands and resembles the venomous sea snake. It has an excellent sense of smell to seek out its prey hidden beneath the sand surface.

3



It is the largest species of fish on the Earth. It resembles a whale, but is actually a slow-moving filter feeder shark.

4



Also known as carpenter sharks, these fish are characterised by a long, narrow, flattened nose extension, lined with sharp transverse teeth, arranged in a way that resembles a saw.

5



It is a sea cucumber. It is found about 1.5 miles deep in the Celebes Sea in the Western Pacific (east of Borneo).

6



Also known as the seawolf or sea cat, this marine fish is distinguished by the natural antifreeze they produce to keep their blood moving fluidly in their very cold climate.

Fact File

The **Chimaera**, also known as the ghost shark or spookfish, are believed to be the oldest known fish in existence, having split from sharks nearly 400 million years ago. They live in temperate ocean floors down to 8,500 ft deep. They also have gill covers or opercula like bony fishes.
