Living	Non-living

We see several living and non-living things around us such as, plants, animals, human beings, insects and birds etc. Furniture, buildings vehicles, air, water, soil etc. are some non-living things. Our environment consists of both living and non-living things. Everything in our surroundings makes up our environment.

Natural Resources

The things that are given to us by nature are called natural resources. We breathe air, we drink water, we get the soil to plant new trees, and many other things that we get from the earth such as gas, petrol etc. All of these things are natural resources.

Types of Pollution

Air Pollution

All living beings need air to breathe. All the plants, animals and human beings need clean air but it is getting dirty and polluted day by day.

Air Pollution Factors:

- ❖ The smoke and other harmful gases from factories and industries mix into air.
- Smoke of crackers, dust and different types of garbage mix into air and make it dirty.
- Burning of fuel causes smoke that mixes with air.
- Smoke coming out from vehicles also causes air pollution.

Fact Byte/-

Our atmosphere has a layer to protect us from ultraviolet rays of the Sun. This layer is called the 'ozone layer'. But some harmful gases are damaging this layer.



Air Pollution

Effects of Air Pollution:

- Air pollution has a very bad effect on human health.
- Due to dust and smoke, our eyes become red and watery and start itching.
- ❖ Asthma, various allergies and lung problems etc. are caused due to air pollution.

Water Pollution

Water is essential for survival of all living beings. We need water for drinking and many other activities. Animals cannot live without water too. Farmers need water to grow crops. But we have polluted all the water bodies such as rivers, lakes, ponds etc. Our harmful activities have badly affected our sources of water.



Water Pollution

Water Pollution Factors:

- Rivers are mostly used for washing clothes, cattle bathing and other cleaning activities. This dirt and soap pollute the water.
- The dirty water from cities and towns flow directly into rivers through sewer lines and make water polluted.

❖ Factories do not arrange for safe disposal of their waste water and supply it directly to rivers. It has harmful chemicals and other poisonous garbage that makes water unfit for consumption.

- Sometimes, ships spill oil and other chemicals on the surface of water that causes severe conditions for aquatic animals and human too.
- * Harmful water causes infections. Crops grown in such water make our food polluted.

Effects of water Pollution:

- ❖ Diseases like cholera, jaundice, typhoid etc. spread through dirty water.
- Dirty water causes diseases in animals and plants.

Land Pollution

Several types of solid and liquid waste materials thrown on land and misuse of minerals cause land pollution.

Land Pollution Factors:

- Many harmful chemicals and fertilizers make the soil contaminated.
- ❖ Factories throw their solid and liquid waste on land that also pollute the soil.
- Household cleaning agents, phenyl etc. also pollute the land.



Land Pollution

Effects of Land Pollution:

- Soil gets contaminated that cause diseases in crops, fruits and vegetable plants. Consumption of this contaminated food makes human beings and animals sick.

Noise Pollution

Unpleasant and loud sound is called noise. Too much noise causes noise pollution.

Noise Pollution Factors:

- ❖ Ear bursting sounds of horns and vehicles give rise to noise pollution.
- Excessive use of loud speakers and DJs cause noise pollution.
- ❖ High volume of television, radio, etc also causes noise pollution.
- Sound of powerful fire crackers also adds to noise pollution.


Rain water harvesting is the method through which we can conserve rain water.
